Thank you for your interest in The Enlisted Association (TREA) National Auxiliary Scholarship Program. Enclosed are the basic documents which are required for anyone applying for acceptance of the "The Enlisted Association (TREA) National Auxiliary Scholarship Program."

Applicants must be a graduating High School Senior, High School graduate, or currently enrolled in a College, University, or Vocational/Technical School as a full-time student.

The applicant must have a parent or grandparent who is currently a member in good standing of The Enlisted Association (TREA) National Auxiliary. The Auxiliary member must have been in good standing for at least 12 months prior to June 1, 2026, deadline for return of the scholarship application. Children/grandchildren may also apply if their parent or grandparent was an auxiliary member in good standing prior to their demise. Applicants may apply for scholarship through TREA and TREA Auxiliary, however, will not be awarded both Scholarship in the same year.

It is important that the 2026 application, together with all the supporting documentation, be postmarked **NO LATER THAN June 1, 2026**. Any application bearing a postmark **LATER THAN June 1, 2026**, and /or incomplete, **WILL NOT** be considered by The Enlisted Association (TREA) National Auxiliary Scholarship Committee.

1. A word essay with a minimum of 250 words (typed only – handwritten will not be accepted) on the following topic:

Two (2) letters of recommendation (i.e., instructors, counselors, clergy, etc.). These letters must accompany this application but may be enclosed in a sealed envelope.

1. A copy of your most current official high school or college transcript. If the school will be sending attach a brief note so stating.
2. A copy of a letter, with date of acceptance from the institution you plan to attend.
3. A recent 2" x 3" photograph of yourself (for publicity use only).
4. A completed and notarized application release form (included in this application).

Applications that don't include **ALL** the supporting documentation will be returned.
