My thoughts and goals about/for TREA:
Let me say that the current and past BOD's have been doing a good job as stewards of TREA. We have been fortunate to so many exceptional people who care about our organization on the BOD. That having been said, things have been changing and while TREA has made some changes to try and keep up, there is more we need to do:
1) We need to reinvigorate the organization, provide value to newer and younger members and differentiate ourselves from other veterans groups least we continue to join them in a continuing downward spiral to extinction.
2) Membership dues cannot support the organization. We need to look for additional sources of revenue. Currently we only have a single sponsor and that revenue is declining based on a declining membership base. We need to recruit additional sponsors throughout the year and especially for the convention.
3) The convention needs to be revenue positive and not a burdensome cost for the organization. To do this we need to provide value to the people who take the time and expense to come to convention. Perhaps a way to accomplish this is to find sponsors who will conduct seminars on various items of interest to attendees. Just a thought.
4) Lastly, our annual operating budget needs to be balanced. We cannot continue to run in the RED just to "keep the doors open". After the operating budget is balanced, if we want to spend reserves on a special project or program to increase membership and or bring in additional revenue then we can choose to do so, BUT those projects/programs need well defined success criteria put, they need to be managed, monitored reported on a regular basis. Only then will we know if its money well spent so we can cancel what's not working and support what is.
