It is important that the 2025 application, together with all the supporting documentation, be postmarked **NO LATER THAN June 1, 2025**. Any application bearing a postmark **LATER THAN June 1, 2025**, and /or incomplete, **WILL NOT** be considered by The Enlisted Association (TREA) National Auxiliary Scholarship Committee.

1. A word essay with a minimum of 250 words (typed only – handwritten will not be accepted) on the following topic:

Two (2) letters of recommendation (i.e., instructors, counselors, clergy, etc.). These letters must accompany this application but may be enclosed in a sealed envelope.

2. A copy of your most current official high school or college transcript. If the school will be sending this transcript under separate cover, attach a brief note so stating.
3. A copy of a letter, with date of acceptance from the institution you plan to attend.
4. A recent 2" x 3" photograph of yourself (for publicity use only).
5. A completed and notarized application release form (included in this application).

Application that doesn't include ALL this supporting documentation will be returned.
