Applicants must be a graduating High School Senior, High School graduate, or be currently enrolled in a College, University, or Vocation/Technical School as a full time student.

The applicant must have a parent or grandparent who is currently a member in good standing of The Enlisted Association (TREA) National Auxiliary. The Auxiliary member must have been in good standing for at least 12 months prior to the June 1, 2022 deadline for return of the scholarship application. Children/grandchildren may also apply if their parent or grandparent was an Auxiliary member in good standing prior to their demise.

It is important that the 2022 application, together with all the supporting documentation be postmarked **NO LATER THAN June 1, 2022**. Any application bearing a postmark **LATER THAN June 1, 2022**, and /or incomplete, **WILL NOT** be considered by THE Enlisted Association (TREA) National Auxiliary Scholarship Committee.

1. A word essay with a minimum of 250 words (typed only – handwritten will not be accepted) on the following topic:

"Does teaching Critical Race Theory enhance or diminish the educational experience of students in American Schools?"

- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendation (i.e., instructors, counselors, clergy, etc.). These letters must accompany this application but may be enclosed in a sealed envelope.
- 3. A copy of your most current official high school or college transcript. If the school will be sending this transcript under separate cove, attach a brief note so stating.
- 4. A copy of a letter, with date of acceptance from the institution you plan to attend.
- 5. A recent 2" x 3" photograph of yourself (for publicity use only).
- 6. A completed and notarized application release form (included in this application).
